COMPLAINT FOR DIVORCE

Plaintiff would show that:

1. Plaintiff is a resident of South Carolina and has been for more than one (1) year prior to the commencement of this action.

2. On information and belief, Defendant is a resident of _____ County, State of South Carolina.

3. The parties to this action were married to each other on or about _____ in _____ County, State of _____.

4. The parties last lived together as husband and wife in _____ County on or about _____ at which time they separated and have lived separate and apart since that time.

5. The parties have lived separate and apart continuously without cohabitation for more than one (1) year prior to the commencement of this action.

6. There is no collusion between the parties and a reconciliation is not possible.

7. Plaintiff is informed and believes that Plaintiff is entitled to an absolute divorce, *a vinculo matrimonii*, on the statutory grounds of one (1) year's continuous separation.

9. Plaintiff does not desire alimony from the Defendant at this time nor anytime in the future.

10. There is no property, personal, real or otherwise, obtained by either party during the marriage that needs to be divided by this Court and there are no debts which need to be divided by the court.
