- Your parent(s)' 2007 Federal Income Tax Return (if you are a dependent student)
- Your parent(s)' Social Security Number (can be found on Social Security card)
- Your parent(s)' date of birth and marital status
- Your parent(s)' month and year they were married, separated, divorced, or widowed
- Your 2007 untaxed income records - Social Security, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families, welfare, or veterans benefits records
- US Department of Education PIN Numbers (You can apply for your Federal PIN at www.pin.ed.gov)

2009-2010 FAFSA (Fall 09, Spring 10, and Summer 10 semesters)

- Your Social Security Number (can be found on Social Security card)
- Your driver's license (if any)
- Your W-2 Forms and other records of money earned
- Your (and your spouse's, if you are married) 2008 Federal Income Tax Return - IRS Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, or 1040Telefile; foreign tax return; or tax return for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia
- Your parent(s)' 2008 Federal Income Tax Return (if you are a dependent student)
- Your parent(s)' Social Security Number (can be found on Social Security card)
- Your parent(s)' date of birth and marital status
- Your parent(s)' month and year they were married, separated, divorced, or widowed
- Your 2008 untaxed income records - Social Security, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families, welfare, or veterans benefits records
- US Department of Education PIN Numbers (You can apply for your Federal PIN at www.pin.ed.gov)

ONLY if you can answer YES to one of the following questions, are you an independent student:

- Are you at least 24 years old by December 31 of the award year covered by the FAFSA?
- As of today, are you married?
- Do you have children who receive more than half their support from you?
- Do you have other dependents (other than children or spouse) who live with you and who receive more than half their support from you?
- Are you an orphan or ward/dependent of the court?
- Are you a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces?
- Are you currently serving on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces for purposes other than training?
- Are your parent(s) deceased?
